REACH Scholars Receive:

Mentoring:

- Scholars meet with the mentors at least two times per month at school.
- Mentors support the scholar throughout his/her secondary school career and beyond.

Academic Coaching:

- Academic coaches work with each student to develop concrete college and career plans.
- Coaches monitor academic progress, attendance, and behavior throughout middle and high school.
- Coaches provide additional academic support when needed.

REACH Scholarship:

- Scholars are awarded up to \$2,500 per year (for up to 4 years-\$10,000 total) to be used at any HOPE-eligible two- or four-year college of their choice.
- University partnerships are matching and double matching the public and privately funded college scholarships. The University of Georgia, Georgia Southern University, Georgia State University, Georgia Tech Institute of Technology, and Mercer University are all currently double matching the \$10,000 scholarship.
