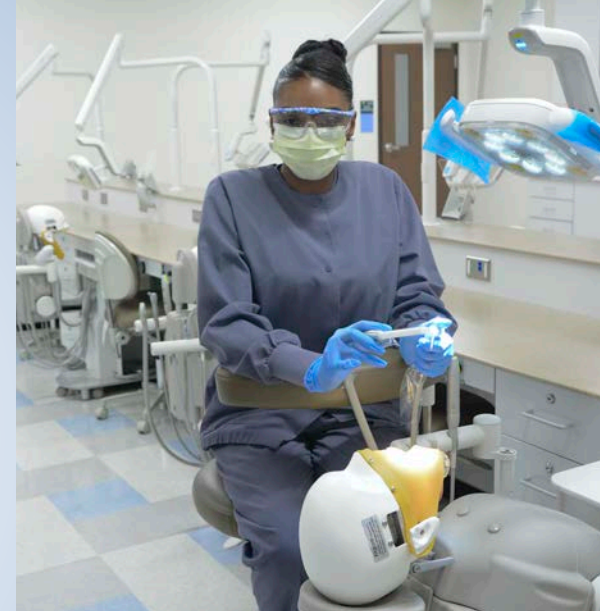

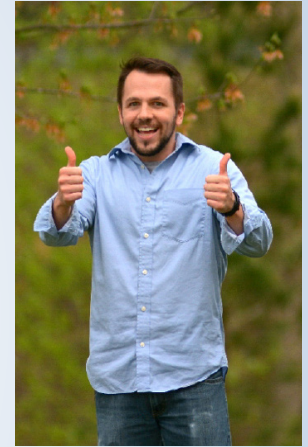
Student Life

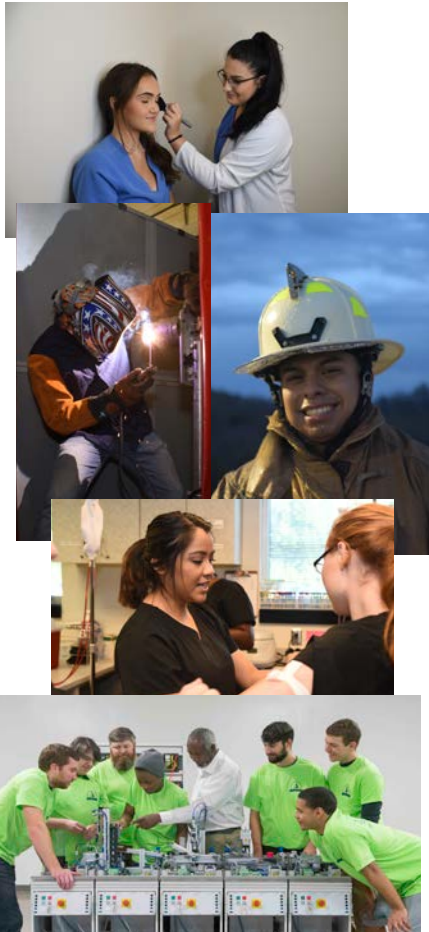
